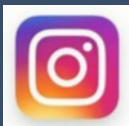

In preparing for the unexpected spills, here are some suggestions and items to have for "just in case".

1. California State Warning Center

2. National Response Center
800-424-8802
3. U.S. Coast Guard/Rio Vista
707-374-2871
4. Have enough pads/absorbents on hand with quantity of fuel/oil on hand.
5. Contact property management with assistance as well as information (if applicable).
6. Be sure you and those around are safe.
