

March 1, 2022 Gate/Access Codes Change

Every February we send out an email to all current clients with new gate codes. This code is only for our clients, and guest codes are provided for visiting family or friends to the marina.

This code is our way of continuing to safe guard your property that you have entrusted us to keep watch over. We take this very seriously and hope you understand our concerns. Your visitors may be known to you, but we only know you and your vehicle. When you call for a guest code, this makes us aware that someone other than you is coming onto the property and therefore alerts us that we should not be surprised by a different car, or stranger that we don't recognize. You are responsible for your guests to follow the same policies that you follow,so be certain they are aware. Guests don't always know what rules go with boating, so do your part to be sure they understand and respect your neighbors boat as well as the rest of the property.
