1. The bicycles, paddle boards and kayaks are for all to enjoy. If you aren't using them, please return them to the shed area so others may use them. Please do not keep them at your boat/dock.
2. The common area of the dock is not to be used as a gathering area. Some people feel uncomfortable trying to get by to their boats with large groups. Please feel free to gather on the main deck for your comfort and others.
3. Be a kind neighbor and roll up your extra dock lines so no one trips and they look much nicer staying out of the water and thrown on the dock.
4. Be sure to separate your garbage and recycle. All boxes need to be broken down to make room in the carts for everyone on your dock. Think kind neighbor.
5. Restrooms and Laundry facilities are closed on Monday and Thursday from 8-Noon for cleaning. Be sure to make note of it so you aren't caught off guard.
6. Be sure to make reservations for the picnic areas, even if it's for an afternoon BBQ. Contact the office for availability and setting up your gathering.




Why so strict on the 5 mph in the marina?


