Tis' the Season

As many know, we have different "bug", "bird", and "weather", seasons.

Right now, we are getting into bee/wasp/meat eater/hornet season for the bugs. We suggest the following:

1. Be sure all openings are sealed as good as possible. These bugs like sail covers, nooks and cranny areas to stay warm in the cooler weather.

Next, weather is a big part of the season. If you are not planning on taking your boat out for a leisurely trip, we highly recommend the following:

- 1. Remove your Jib to prevent unfurling in high winds (FYI, we had 6 unfurl in January).
- 2. Check your dock lines any fraying means lines should be replaced; they won't give you a clue before they break.
- 3. All lose items should be secured and tied down.
- 4. Halyards are key if you need bungees, we have them in the office.
- 5. Squeaking fenders can be fixed with covers. Check out our pricing for fender covers from West Marine if you are interested.
