Where are you with your insurance?

With the recent fire, and sinking, of two boats it got us looking at everyone's coverage with new eyes. The two things we found is that there is a lot of different "wording" and second, a lot of different "coverage" out there.


What does this mean to you, or for you?

First, we require a <u>current copy</u> of your insurance policy/declaration page every year on file. As a little sidebar, we also require a current copy of your registration or documentation paper as well, but that is for another newsletter. This has been our policy for 15 years for both forms of documents.

Here are some things for you to review:

- 1. Your policy should list Owl Harbor Marina as "Additional Insured", NOT, "Additional Interest".
- 2. Naming Owl Harbor Marina as additional insured on the Liability (P & I) policy grants no rights of ownership in the vessel.
- If you have a personal "Umbrella Policy", this is acceptable provided it must specifically list the boat insurance policy as underlying coverage. We must be listed on this as additional insured as well.
- 4. We require a minimum of \$300k per accident, liability, pollution coverage. This is a min. amount, and more marinas are requiring \$500k due to the damage that can be caused in an accident.
- The wording does need to list the above to cover liability expenses.
- 6. If you have an accident and only have liability coverage, your boat will not be covered for any replacement or repair read that one again...
- See if you have hull/wreckage removal for the fair market value of your vessel. This may be important to avoid a hefty bill to remove your vessel.

These are things you should review and investigate regarding your policy and discuss with your insurance provider. We are reviewing the policies and will be in touch if your coverage does not meet the necessary requirements. Unfortunately, the time we all need insurance from an accident, it is too late to make changes. It's a product needed to avoid unsurmountable expenses or loss after the fact.
