Three Mile Slough Bridge Closure

The lift span of the Three Mile Slough Bridge will be secured in the <u>"Closed to Navigation"</u> position from <u>January 2, 2024,</u> <u>through June 30, 2024,</u> to conduct major mechanical and electrical rehabilitation. During the work, the lift span will not be able to open for the passaae of vessels.

Safety First

We recently had a boat fire, which left two boats on the bottom of the slough. The cause – <u>a propane heater</u>!

To start, no one was hurt or injured, which was our gift this Christmas. It could have turned bad, but gratefully it did not. Instead, it has made us aware of a few things: the use of propane, and your safety standards/best practices, and of course, insurance policies and requirements.

You may not be aware of a problem with your propane, but here are a few things to review:

- 1. Can you smell something foul propane has an odor compared to sulfur, rotten eggs, dead animal?
- Propane is heavy and goes to the lowest points to lay and fill – your bilge or engine area are suitable places to lay low.
- Check propane venting systems to avoid Carbon Monoxide – you cannot taste or smell carbon monoxide, but it is a dangerous gas, produced when any fuel burns.
- Be sure all systems are operating correctly do not try to install, modify, or repair valves, regulators, connectors, controls, or other cylinder/tank parts.
- 5. Install a simple Kidde Carbon Monoxide Detector, Propane, Natural, Methane & Explosive Gas Alarm – Amazon has one to plug into a wall with a 9-volt battery backup with Digital LED Display for about \$50. Or something to let you know there is a problem/leak.
- Do you have the proper coverage on your insurance? You may think you are covered, but we will let you know if you are not for berthing at Owl Harbor. We want you covered, and us.

Please let me know if you have any questions, I am always here to help. Also know that propane heaters are not a safe way to go on a boat, and there may be a better solution for your safety and your neighbors.

GRANNY CAKE

1 ½ Cups sugar

- 2 Cups all-purpose flour
- 1 tsp baking soda
- 1/2 tsp salt
- 2 large eggs
- 1 (20 oz.) can crushed pineapple with juice
- 1 Cup brown sugar

1 Cup pecans or walnuts, chopped (or whatever nut you like)

- lcing:
- 1 Cup evaporated milk
- 1/2 Cup sugar
- 1/2 Cup (1 stick) unsalted butter
- 1 tsp vanilla

PREPARATION:

Preheat oven to 350 degrees In a large bowl, whisk together sugar, flour, baking soda and salt, then mix in eggs and pineapple.

Pour batter into your pan and top with an even layer of nuts and brown sugar. Place baking dish in oven and bake for 40-45 mins, or until toothpick inserted in center comes out clean.

While cake cooks, combine evaporated milk, sugar, and butter in a medium saucepan over medium-high heat and bring to a boil.

Remove from heat and stir in vanilla extract, then pour over hot cake. Let cake cool so it absorbs icing then slice, serve, and enjoy!
